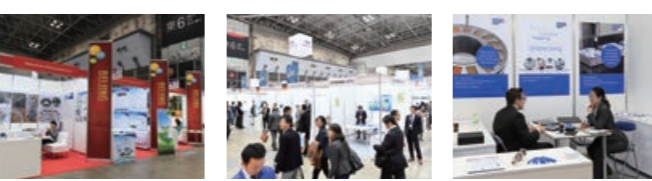

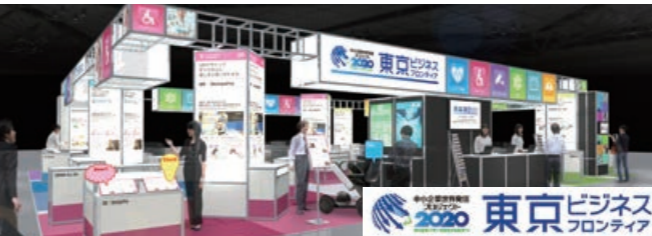
Overseas companies aggressively developing business in Japan will exhibit product technologies and products. Please use this event to find business opportunities with overseas companies as well as to collect information.

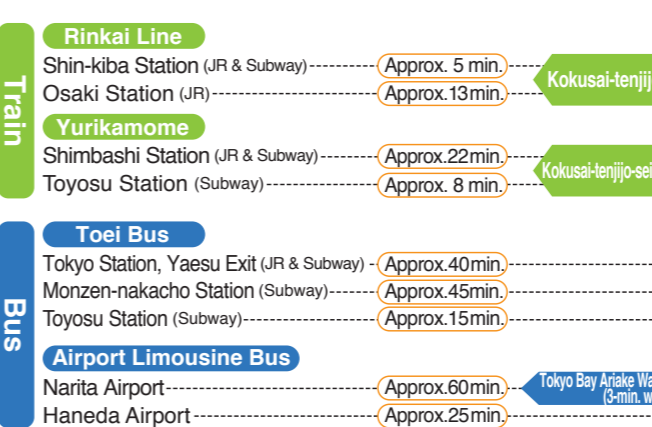
